

# Buckaroo Book Awards

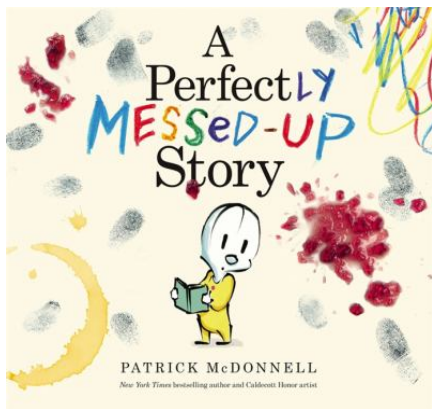

- To honor an author whose book has been enjoyed by Wyoming children.

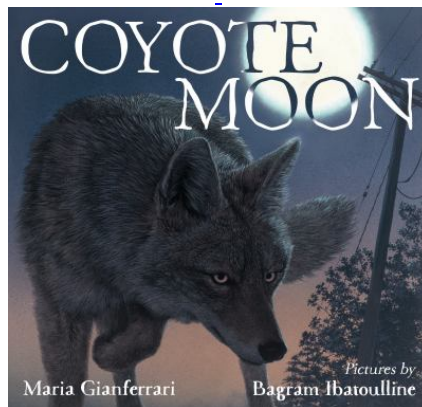
