

Wyoming State Reading Council

Scholarship Regulations

I. Minimum Requirements:

- a. An applicant must be a member in good standing of the Wyoming State Reading Council.

Preference will be given to applicants who have served as a local council or state officer or local council or state committee chair.

- b. An applicant must list reasonable standards concerning scholarship, professional contributions and other evidence of potentiality for future service in the area of reading and to the association.

- c. An applicant must use the scholarship to pursue graduate work or to seek an advanced degree at an approved institution of higher learning.

II. Directions for applying for the scholarship:

- a. Submit your scholarship intentions to the Wyoming State Reading Council no later than June 1st to:

- b. The applicant must provide three letters of reference. These letters must attest to the applicant's scholarship and professional contribution including local and state ILA responsibilities.

III. General conditions of acceptance:

- a. The Wyoming State Reading Council executive board will select the recipient(s) of the scholarship. Within two (2) weeks after the successful applicant is notified of

his/her selection, he/she must notify the Wyoming State Council President of his/her acceptance of the award or he/she will forfeit the award.

b. This implies an obligation on the part of the recipient to make a final report of his/her study to the state president. This report must include (a) a summary of work completed; (b) an official transcript or documentation of coursework; (c) plans for sharing of knowledge and skills gained; (d) a statement concerning future involvement of the plan of study.

IV. Payment of scholarship:

a. Recipient/s may receive up to \$600.00 depending on how many scholarships are awarded. Payment will be in the form of reimbursements upon receipt of verification of expenses.
